




Church Safety Team Protecting the Sheep Active Killer Preparedness Congregation Response Part 1 The West Freeway Church of Christ, White Settlement, TX December 29, 2019 The Killer shot and killed to wo members of the church before he was fatally short by a safety team member ending the attack within six esconds. The victims were identified as a safety team member, and an usher. The attacker, wearing a false beard and a halt, briefly spoke to the usher before drawing a shotgum. Two safety team members dever their pistols in self-defense. The killer opened fire, straking one of the safety team members and fired again at the usher, mortally wounding them. The killer then aimed their shotgun toward the congregation, and was then shot by another safety team member. The church spokesman stated that five or six other team members had drawn their pistols in response to the wine's selection, but only the one team member load fired their pistol.


Church Safety Team Protecting the Sheep Active Killer Preparedness Congregation Response Part 1 The West Freeway Church of Christ, White Settlement, TX December 29, 2019 The Killer The gumnan was identified as a 43-year-old man. • He was divorced in 2010 after being married for eight years. • The killer was charged with felony assault and battery with a dangerous weapon after he attacked the owner of a Chickasha, Oklahoma, doughnut shop in 2011. He charged with arson in Oklahoma and the court ruled him mentally incompetent to stand trial ordering him committed to a psychiatric facility for treatment. Hi ise-wife shared he was repeatedly fed by the congregation before he grew angry, when church officials refused to give him money, according to court records and the minister. Upon entering that morning, he was wearing a fake beard and wig and immediately raised the supplicions of the security deacons serving the church The security team was hesitant to approach the killer because, at the time, they didn't recognize him and believed he may have been concealing flavs he was embarrassed of, such as severe burns or hair loss from chemotherapy treatments. • The killer had been arrested multiple times in the past: In 2009 in River Oaks, Texas, for unpaid traffic tickets and then again in 2016 in Linden, New Jersey, for unlawful possession of a weapon.










Church Safety Team Protecting the Sheep Active Killer Preparedness Congregation Response Part 1 A Final Word – It will not Stop May 5, 2024 – North Braddock, PA Man Attempts to Shoot Pastor A 26 year old man walked into a church service and pulled a pistol and attempted to shoot the pastor as he was speaking. The pistol failed to fire and the attacker was wrestled down to the ground and disarmed by congregation members. A family member was later found shot to death in the attacker's home and has been charged with that death. The attacker was not known to the pastor. The attacker toid police that "God had toid him to do it." Like 21:17 (NASBS) – "and you will be hated by all because of My name."
